SCHOOL BREAK FEEDING PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN: The Community Outreach Committee met this past week and during our meeting, Keith Whitacre shared information regarding the School Break Feeding Program. The statistics were alarming, and as a committee we unanimously decided this was a program we and our church family should get behind and support. Children in Lake County receive free breakfast and lunch during the school year; however, during the summer months, families in need struggle to feed their children. We as a committee and as a church whole believe no child should go to bed hungry and are asking for your help to prevent that within our community. All proceeds collected will be given to the Neighborhood Center of South Lake and will be used to purchase food for children in the South Lake area who rely on school-issued meals. **Beginning this Sunday, May 26th**, **please join us in the Breezeway where you can choose an envelope from our fundraising wall and help provide food for the School Break Feeding Program.** Some of the envelopes have a surprise in them for you too! Also needed are canned pasta, cereal, mac & cheese, shelf stable milk, snack bars, oatmeal packets, and peanut butter.

Some statistics shared with us regarding the School Break Feeding Program: before Covid, the program could feed a child for \$10.00 for the summer and today it now costs \$50.00 for that same child. The Snap Summer EBT program is a government matching program with the state that our state did not match, and the Stamp Out Hunger program, which is also counted on for food is about 70% less than last year. We are currently targeting about 600 kids for the summer feeding which costs about \$30,000. In the past we fed over 1,000 children so with more funding and food we can feed more children. Additionally, there are families on a program called Alice, they usually cycle out; however, with the rising food costs, families need to stay in the program longer which puts a strain on all the food needs within the community.


