This is going to be a team effort as we will no longer be sending out multiple email reminders for any meetings and/or events through the Church Office. We are asking for your help by using the communication tool we send out on Saturday mornings to update your calendars and agendas for the week, month, quarter, year.

If you oversee a committee, group, team, guild, church-wide event, please feel free to collaborate with your individual "communities" in setting up parameters and such for sending group email reminders and/or updates and changes to meetings among yourselves. Do you have set meeting dates and times each month or do your meetings fluctuate and need a reminder here and there? Discuss at your next meetings and decide as a group how much you want to communicate via email and who will oversee it.

Will there be times when something of urgency comes through and needs sending out at that moment to the Church Family, YES, and when that occurs, we will send out an individual email; however, our goal is to limit the email communication to one email a week. Examples of exceptions to this new process would be when we need to communicate the death of a church family member, or an immediate need for a church family member, and/or the emailing of our quarterly Ministry Schedules. There will at times be exceptions; however, our goal is to limit the number of emails you receive.

This new process includes the emails containing the weekly bulletins. We will be including links in the Saturday email where you can view and/or download the bulletins for Sunday services. This new process will begin this week and will include the links for Sunday, July 21st bulletins.

If you want any information announced and shared in the Saturday communication, please be sure to have it to me by the Tuesday prior to the Saturday email you would like the information included. For example, if you would like information included in the Saturday, July 27th email, all information needs to be to me no later than Tuesday, July 23rd.

We appreciate your understanding and support as we implement this new process. We hope it helps free up extra work time on our end to focus on other needed areas and hope it helps all of you in freeing up the number of emails hitting your inboxes. As always, please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
