2025 STEWARDSHIP LETTER FROM GLEN MARTIN, STEWARDSHIP CHAIR

December 12, 2024

Dear St. Matthias family,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

As followers of Jesus Christ, we are sometimes asked, why do we attend church?
